NOTIFICATION

The candidates who have been allotted a seat in B.Tech. Programs of Indian Institute of Information Technology (IIIT) Sonapat Under DASA/SII counseling process for current Academic year 2022-23 are required to report **ONLINE** during 2th -4th November 2022 by following the process as explained below.

1. There will be online reporting duty **02-04 November** and the candidates are not required to visit the Institute physically for reporting.
2. The candidates who are required to pay Balance Institute Fee, **if applicable as per Annexure -B, must pay through NEFT/RTGS/Net Banking/UPI made before 04.11.2022**. The payment proof is required to be submitted with other document which will be sent through E-mail.
3. The physical reporting and allotment of hostel will be made on November 13, 2022 after their arrival.
4. The orientation program for 1st Semester will be on **November 14, 2022** and the classes commence from **November 15, 2022** in offline mode only. The schedule & time table for orientation program & Classes will be available on the Institute website in due course of time.
5. The candidates are required to produce medical fitness certificate on prescribed pro-forma available on the portal. The medical certificate must be certified by Registered Medical Practitioner (RMP) in India.
6. The candidates who passed their 10+2 examination from foreign country are also required to produce HIV -ve report. The HIV test must be carried out on arrival of the candidates in India.
7. The candidates are advised to produced COVID-19 vaccination certificate.
8. The candidate are required to visit the Institute Website (www.iiitsonapat.ac.in) regularly for latest updates.

- v) Proof of passing english as a subject in school education at least at the level of 10th class or equivalent 10th Board Mark Sheet/Birth Certificate having particulars of candidate including Date of Birth (DOB)/ Passport or citizen Card [for Foreign Nationals]
- vi) Date of Birth (DOB) Certificate issued by the appropriate Govt Authority, in case DOB is not mentioned on 10th Board Mark Sheet
- vii) JEE (Mains) Score Card of 2022 issued by the National Testing Agency.
- viii) Aadhar Card from Indian Nationals/ Citizenship Card (valid in lieu of Passport as per Govt. of India guidelines) for Bhutan & Nepal/ Passport and valid visa for others. Further, in case of Indian Nationals, if address is different from Aadhar Card, then any of the documents such as Driving License, Passport, electricity Bill, Ration Card, Voter Card etc. is also required to submitted.
- ix) CIWG Category (*Proof of parents working in CIWG countries along with valid VISA and Passport of their parents and self*) [*Such category of candidate must pass 10+2 examination from Gulf Countries as notified under CIWG categories by Govt. of India*].
- x) Migration/ School Leaving Certificate and Character Certificate (*from the Institute/ School last attended*)
- xi) Undertaking duly filled and signed on the prescribed format as per **Annexure-C**.
- xii) Medical fitness certificate issued by the Registered Medical Practitioner (RMP) on DASA/SII -2022 format **Annexure-D**.
- xiii) Bank account details: Cancelled Cheque/First page of Pass Book (Bank Account must be in the name of candidate only) for all type of transaction in the Institute including refund of fee, disbursement of scholarship.

2. Passport Size Color Photo and Signature in JPG format (Less than 1 MB File Size each)

The candidates are also required to upload color passport size photograph having light background and in light color dress and image of signature on plain paper using black pen in JPG format during online reporting (file size must be less than 1 MB).

Note: - As per Govt. of India Guidelines, Digi Locker downloaded self-attested copy having bar-code QR code will be considered equivalent to original.
